Allow your spirit to wash over us and give us strength to walk together as one.

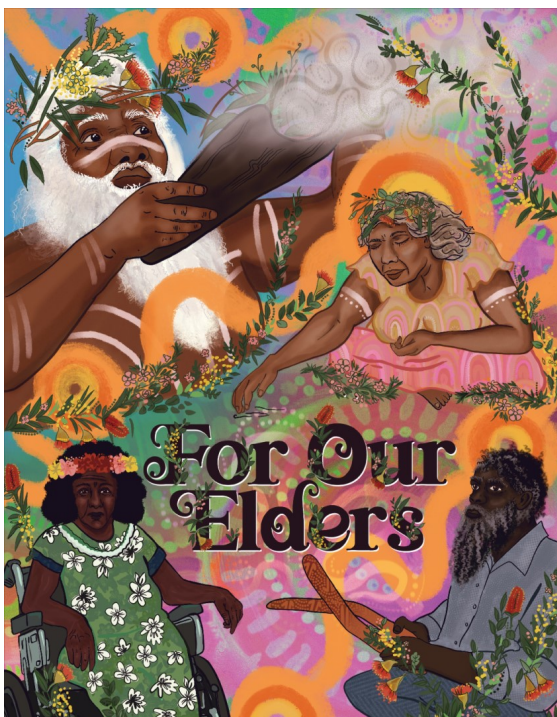
