ST VINCENT DE PAUL CHRISTMAS APPEAL

This Christmas, we are focussing on the ongoing impacts of the cost-of-living crisis which has seen already vulnerable people pushed into poverty with barely anything to hold on to and facing the brink of homelessness. The cost-of-living crisis is causing families who were already struggling further hardship and driving a growing number of people to seek assistance for the first time. Workers in full-time employment, families on dual incomes and renters burdened by the soaring cost of housing have turned to the Society through necessity. Alarmingly, the number of people turning to our members for the first time has increased from one-in-four to one-in-three over the past year. While cost of living pressures have occurred across the board, the most acute impacts are felt by those with the least capacity to absorb the financial, social and wellbeing blows.

Our Christmas Appeal plays a critical role in ensuring our members are able to continue to provide support to the people we assist and that our services are able to meet their needs. As always, we are hoping to encourage as many donations as possible to ensure the Society's good works continue. Our appeal will start next week and will run for three weekends. The 'giving tree' will be put up again with appeal and for needle we
